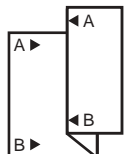

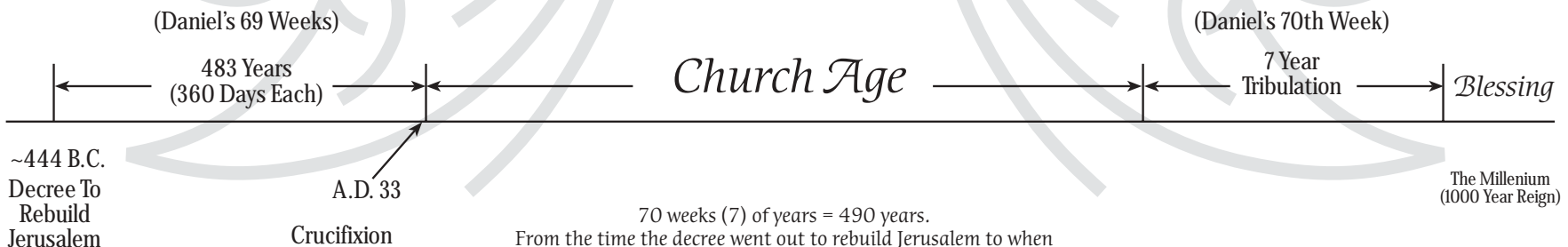

Prophecy

God's timetable for His plan began with the decree to rebuild Jerusalem and ends with the tribulation. He gave the Jewish people 490 years to complete the promises he made. When the Messiah was cut off the clock stopped. To the wise this is revealed as the church age spoken of in Luke chapter 21:24 — "They will fall by the sword & will be taken as prisoners to all the nations. Jerusalem will be trampled on by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled". In only 7 years, God will deliver the Jews and the earth we know will be filled with the presence of the Messiah. The clock, for the last 7 years in His great plan, will not start-up until the Anti-Christ signs a peace treaty, for a time duration of 7-years, with the Nation of Israel.



70 weeks (7) of years = 490 years.
From the time the decree went out to rebuild Jerusalem to when the "Anointed One will be cut off" (Daniel 9:26) is 69 weeks (7) of years = 483 years.
The Jewish 360 day per year calendar and other ancient calendars are compared—the ending of the prophetic 483 years coincides with Jesus entering into Jerusalem on the donkey in 16 April in 33 A.D.

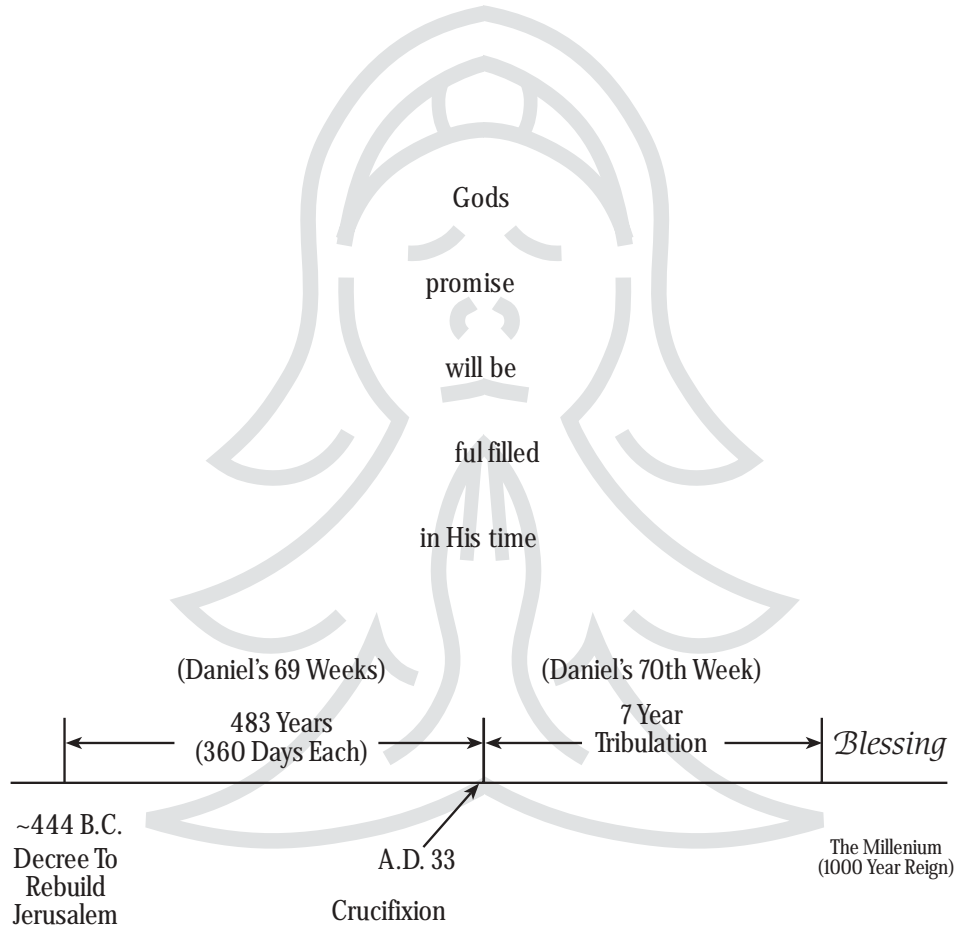
A few days later he was crucified, precisely as Daniel's prophecy predicted. This leaves one week of years (7) = 7 years of the prophecy that is still future.
That week is what we call the "Tribulation".
